## TRAIL NOTES

This walk takes in the highest point in the park, Andrew Hill, from there a descent, which encounters two tributaries of the Yea River-Island Creek and Mountain Creek.

Forested earth track. Path may be overgrown or require minor water crossing.

Andrew Hill is in the Wombelano Block of the Kinglake National Park. The park was opened in February 1928 after several years of campaigning by a music professor, William Laver.
