TRAIL NOTES

This part of Kinglake National Park used to be heavily logged up to 1980. The walk follows tracks over the forested summit of Andrew Hill; Dusty Miller Track named after the indigenous, prolifically growing shrub.

Follow first 5km of Andrew Hill Circuit, then follow Dusty Miller Track.



DID YOU KNOW?

Dusty Miller Track is named after the indigenous, silvery-grey, perennial shrub abundant along the trail.
