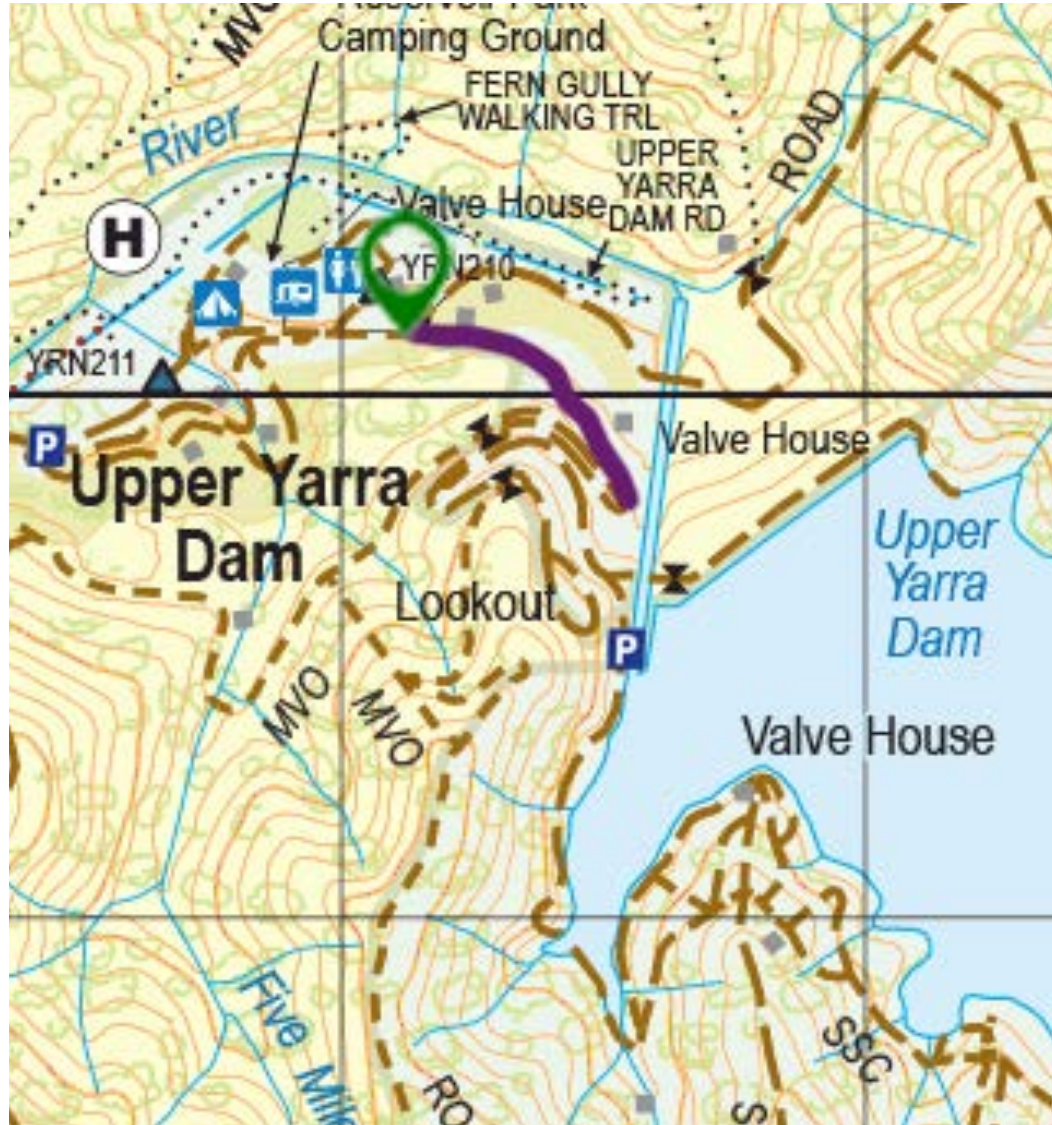

Flora: Maintained gardens and grounds are surrounded by pristine bushlands

Fauna: Greater Gliders, Sugar Gliders, Wombats, Swamp Wallabies, Possums, bats, Samba Deer, owls, fish and Kookaburras

Facilities: Facilities available at McVeigh's Picnic area and includes an information shelter, gas and wood fired barbecues, rotunda, toilets and picnic tables. Wet weather hall in the grounds provides sheltered seating, electric barbecues and hot water.

* Melbourne Water is upgrading the Upper Yarra Reservoir dam wall and the Park will re-open mid-2021

TRAIL NOTES

Stroll along the track to the viewing platform, and watch the water flow through the reservoir on its way to Melbourne

Flat, easy pathway to viewing platform sections and some steps.

The Upper Yarra Reservoir Park, where the Brimbonga Walking Track is situated, was originally a small town constructed for the workers who built the dam between 1947 and 1957.
