TRAIL NOTES

Along the track are remains of the trestle bridge and tramway which were used in the days when logs were hauled out of the forest by teams of horses and later by steam locomotives.

Earthen groomed surface, with some bridges.



DID YOU KNOW?

Timber was cut from the southern fall of Mt Margaret and a 3' gauge tramway was constructed along the northern bank of the river to transport the logs to the mill. A lowering gear and balanced incline was installed on the slopes of Mt Margaret, and a horse operated tramway reached towards the mount. The tramway system was destroyed in 1939, but was later rebuilt.
