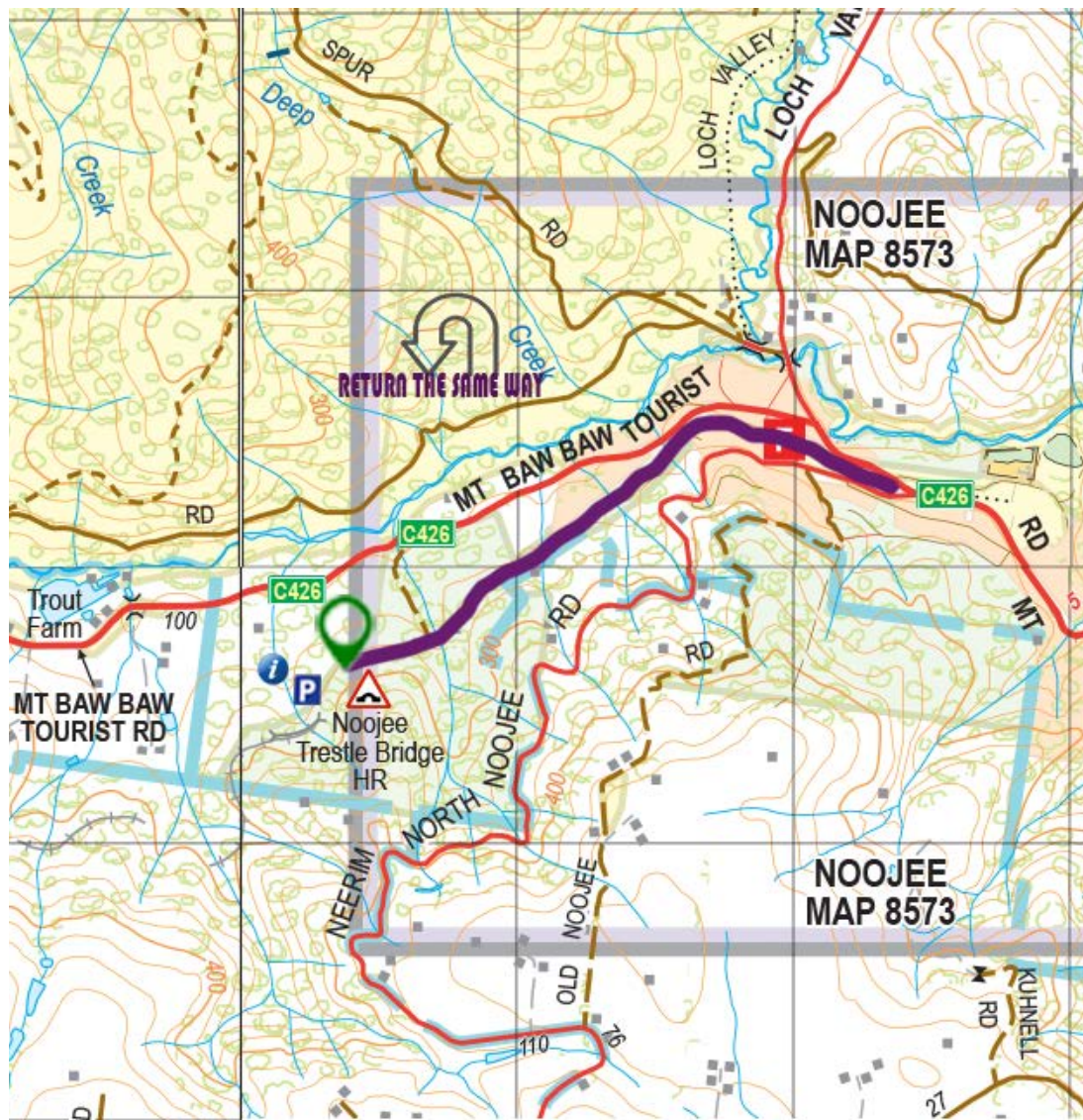

TRAIL NOTES

The Trestle Bridge is an impressive restored timber trestle railway bridge, with the short trail surrounded by tall forest.

Fine gravel surface, shady and sheltered from wind. Steep steps either end of bridge.



DID YOU KNOW?

The bridge is a legacy of the old railway that ran from Noojee to Warragul. It was originally constructed in 1919, but in 1939 was completely burnt down and rebuilt in the same year. The historical bridge spans 102 metres and is 21 metres high.
